1. STEP BY STEP FREESTYLE SKIING

The goal of the presentation is to give you a straightforward picture of where to start, and how to progress through the guests' skills when teaching in the park. The exercises are based on one another and are divided into different skill levels. The Step by Step Freestyle Skiing workshop can be applied to any intermediate ski lesson or course, although it works best with advanced kids courses (aged 7-14).

The thematic starts with the basics outside the park, (flatland tricks allowing one to understand the physics and essential moves of freestyle skiing). The first level is necessary for a safe progression through the workshop and helps to get a better stance on the skis. The first level is also ideal for guests who want to improve their technique with some fun exercises.

Âfter mastering the basics the exercises are then continued in the park. The workshop continues thought many different skills and exercises and progresses until 540° spins on medium jumps and spins on boxes has been achieved. The workshop will include all the necessary hints, tips, conclusions, movement corrections throughout the exercises.
